

- 19.5 The trust will be an irrevocable Charitable Trust.
- 20 Notwithstanding the provision of the aims & the objects of the trust is charitable, it shall be lawful for the trust to acquire the trust fund, fees, donations etc, without profit motive at such prices or prices that the trustees may fix from time to time provided however that net proceeds thereof or the net profits there from shall not be utilized by the trustees excepts for the objects of the Trust and for the benefits of the general public and not for the personal benefit of the members and any incidental benefit to its members would not against its charitable character strictly.

That, all disputes concerning the Trust estate shall be tried and decided in the Courts at Bhubaneswar only.
